

Marriage registry:

Two people of Mexican nationality can celebrate their civil marriage at the Mexican consulate.

Requirements:

1. Complete application (Do not leave any blank spaces).
2. Proof of Mexican citizenship for both applicants. These can be a certified birth certificate or a Mexican passport. (Birth certificates will be kept by the consulate)
3. A valid picture ID. (Passport, consular ID, voter's registration ID)
4. Proof of address. (Utility bill, rent receipt, etc.)
5. A total of 4 witnesses. Each witness must be 18 years-old or older, have a valid picture ID, and provide proof of address. (Applicants' parents cannot be witnesses)
6. Health certificate. It must be signed by a licensed physician and certify that applicants do not suffer from any chronic, incurable, contagious, or hereditary disease (i.e. HIV, Syphilis, etc.). Health certificates are good for 15 days only; it is recommended to first schedule a date of marriage in order to ensure validity.
7. All documents must be original/certified and include two photocopies.

Fees:

Marriage ceremony -\$43.

Marriage certificate -\$13.

Process:

Take all required documents to the main consular office located at 431 Raleigh view Rd. Raleigh, NC 27610. Documents are accepted between 8AM and 1PM only.

Once approved, applicants will be assigned a specific date and time for the marriage celebration and marriage certificate issuance.

On the assigned date, both applicants must be present accompanied by their four witnesses. If any of the participants is missing, the process shall be canceled.

Underage marriage

If one of the applicants is under 18 years of age, the minor's parents must be present.

Parents must show a valid picture ID and a notarized letter authorizing the marriage.

If one or both parents are unable to show up at the consulate, a proxy must present a power of attorney granting him/her authorization to act on his/her behalf in this matter.
